A range of communication technologies will be explored, and training will include:

- exploring the SETT framework with case studies about users with complex communication needs
- exploring telecommunication functions of communication apps and software such as emails, texts and social media

- guidelines to prescribe mobile technologies, including options for access, setting up and programming of communication devices.
